Last week we also received the fabulous news that Bulphan Church have received their Silver Eco Church Award. This is a great achievement and thank you to Lynda Robertson who submitted the application and kept everyone on track and to everyone at Bulphan whose efforts have enabled this to be possible.

Following the completion of the SHAPE Course, earlier on in the term, in the autumn we will be running an Alpha Course online. The Alpha course seeks to introduce the basics of the Christian faith through a series of talks and discussions. It is described by its organisers as "an opportunity to explore the meaning of life". There are three easy ways to donate to your church through the Parish Giving Scheme. You can

- 1. Set up your Direct Debit online at www.parishgiving.org.uk
- 2. Call the Parish Giving team and they will take you through it, step by step. Their telephone service is on 0333 002 1271, Monday to Friday, 9am 5pm, this will take about 15 minutes.
- 3. Fill in a paper form, available from your Church's Treasurer

If you decide to join this scheme you will be asked the PGS code for the church you are supporting, details as follows:

- Personal bank account details
- You will need to confirm if you want to increase your gift in line with inflation each year
- Confirm if you are eligible for gift aid

Or if you already give regularly please do pray about increasing your giving if you are able to. Sacrificial giving is part of our calling as Christians.

Don't forget that the next Forest Church is at Orsett on Saturday 7th August at 4pm. You need to bring a waterproof, in case it rains and something to sit on. Do give it a try if you have never been. It is a great way to worship God.

Lastly, Morning and Evening Prayer will be back on Saturdays but with Morning Prayer on Saturdays being at the slightly later time of 9am.


