A BOROUGH store launched a collection point on Monday, 16 August where donations of


items that will help victims of domestic abuse can be taken in.

In Grace's memory her family and friends founded the 'Love Grace' appeal. It collects and then distributes handbags filled with essential items. The bags are delivered with a tag which says "Love Grace x" in Grace's handwriting and a flower that she drew, on one side.


The staff will be collecting items including handbags, toiletries, wipes, soaps, make-up and perfumes. You can find out more about the 'Love Grace appeal at
