Amen.

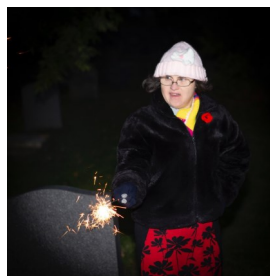

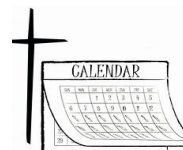
