Sadly, no one came to the service at Bulphan on Wednesday evening, other than the wardens and those who were organising and leading it, which was very disappointing.

On Sunday 19th, we have the Drive-in Carol Service at Arden Hall Farm in Horndon-on-the-Hill. So far, 26 cars have booked .There are 19 places left, so if you are thinking of coming please do get your tickets ASAP, details of how to order tickets are later in the notice sheet.

This Friday, at the Oasis Café, there will be extra stalls, a tombola, a raffle and eats and treats. Similarly, at the Woolmarket in Horndon-on-the Hill, on both 11th and 18th December there is a Christmas Fayre. Details of both of these are on page 2.

On Tuesday, 14th December, our 7.30pm Holy Communion Service will be replaced with a non-Eucharistic Service with prayers for healing. # No Christmas Cards!


