Thank you to everyone who has given their time in service to the Church over the past year. Your ministry and support has been greatly appreciated. I would particularly like to thank the wardens and all the PCC members, some of whom have served, faithfully, in their roles for between 30 and 40 years.

In the New Year, our three parishes will be united to become the Parish of Horndon, Orsett and Bulphan and we will be electing our new PCC, our Wardens, Deanery Synod Reps, Treasurer and Secretary at a special meeting after the morning service at Orsett on Sunday 30th January, to which all members of the electoral roll are invited and eligible to vote. Nomination forms will be available at the back of all three churches at the beginning of January. Please do put this date in your diary and try to come if you are on the electoral roll.

We will also begin to set up Action Groups to focus on different areas of the church's ministry including Prayer, Social Justice and Eco Church, Mission and Evangelism, Children and Young People, Communications, Fundraising etc, so please do pray and ask God whether he might be calling you to use the gifts he has given you by serving on one of these groups.

On 9th January, it is Plough Sunday and we have invited our local farmers to attend this service. We will also be baptising Emmeline and Charlotte Bernard and Bishop Guli will be coming to the service to preach, to conduct the baptism, to bless the agricultural machinery and the work of our local farmers in the forthcoming year and to pray for us as we begin working together as one parish.

This Sunday, 19th December, the Drive-in Carol Service is being held in Horndon full details are on page three. There are still five car spaces available if you would like to attend. Please note that attendance is by ticket only.

On Tuesday 21st December we are holding a Blue Christmas/Longest Night service, 7.30pm at Orsett Church. This service is to reflect a glimpse of the light of Christ 'when Christmas hurts'.

Please not that, in order to give clergy, wardens and sacristans a break after Christmas, there will be no service at Horndon on the morning of Tuesday 28th December and there will not be any Facebook prayers during that week.
