This is just to remind you that our SPCM will be held after the 10am Service at Orsett on 30th January. At this meeting we will be giving thanks for the hard work of all those who have served on the PCCs and electing our new PCC for the Parish of Horndon, Orsett and Bulphan. We will also be inviting people to sign up to join our Action Groups. Everyone on the electoral roll is invited to attend. All are welcome at this service. I encourage you to bring a friend along.


