
Forest Church is a new way of doing church outdoors for all ages.

Supermarkets lose faith

The 2022 Real Easter Egg will not be available in any supermarket. If you are one of the 80,000 people who usually buy at the supermarket then you need to order direct. But be quick as there will not be enough eggs to go round this year. Out of the 80 million Easter eggs sold in this part of the world every year. The Real Easter Egg is the only one which has a copy of the Easter story in the box, is made of Fairtrade chocolate and which supports charitable projects.

The Original, White and Dark eggs include a 24 page Easter story-activity book. They are Palm Oil and plastic free, and include a competition. The Dark also contains a simple Easter guide, designed for adults and 3 dark Mini Squares.

The Fun Pack has an Easter story activity poster and 6 milk chocolate eggs.

The Special Edition has a designer Easter card, a simple guide to Easter, an orange milk chocolate bar and a luxury milk chocolate egg.
