Dear Everyone,

Since we have established our new PCC the Action Groups have begun to meet. The Prayer Action Group has decided they will meet on the third Tuesday of each month to pray for our Parish of Horndon, Orsett and Bulphan and for the mission and ministry of the Church. This group will, generally, be meeting in the Woolmarket in Horndon from 8pm until 9pm but we will make sure that details will be published on the notice sheet as there may be occasions when it is held elsewhere. This is an open group so anyone is welcome to turn up; it is so important that all we do in this Parish is built upon a strong foundation of prayer. The Fundraising Action group has also met and have planned a number of events and will keep us all informed.

Last Sunday we held the first afternoon 'Refresh' Service in Horndon Church. This was an informal service where we used the screen which was generously funded by Horndon Feast and Fayre. We had a lovely time of worship and will be holding this service on the third Sunday of each month at 4pm in Horndon Church. Do come along and give it a try.

Lent is now approaching and we will begin Lent with an Ash Wednesday Service in Bulphan Church on Wednesday 2nd March at 7.30pm. Also, don't forget that the 'Live Lent, Embracing Justice' booklets containing daily readings for both children and adults will be available. Please let me now if you would like one. Adult booklets cost £1.75 each and children's booklets cost £1.25.

During Lent Bishop Guli encourages us to observe a Holy Sabbatical; to use the period of Lent to pause, mark some of the changes we have experienced during this period of great change and then set our faces to the future, leaning into what God is calling us towards. This Holy Sabbatical is not an initiative but an invitation to find creative ways in which individuals and communities, might rest a while in the Lord Jesus – that we might enter the wilderness of Lent with lighter loads, prepared for reflection, refreshment and renewal. Jesus said, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11: 28). So I encourage you to use the period of Lent to find opportunities for prayer and reflection, either alone or alongside others.

Don't forget the Living in Love and Faith Course that begins on Monday 28th February. More details can be found later in this notice sheet. Please let me know if you would like to attend.




