This week we celebrate Palm Sunday, when we remember the day that Jesus entered Jerusalem, hailed by the people as their king. Like the people of the time, we carry palms to greet Jesus. But our palms are shaped into crosses as we prepare for the events of Holy Week, when we remember Jesus' crucifixion on Good Friday before the celebration of his Resurrection on Easter Day.

Our Palm Sunday Services are at Orsett Church. We have a Holy Communion Service at 8.45am followed by a Family Service at 10am. Do join us for one, or both, of the services if you are able.

Details of our Holy Week services can be found later in the notices. At our Easter Day Service, when we will be worshipping together as one church family, we will be admitting two young people to receive Holy Communion. This service will be at Horndon Church at 10am.

I look forward to seeing you during Holy Week as we prepare for celebrating the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.
