It was lovely to share Holy Week and Easter Services with so many of you and it was a privilege for the clergy to prepare two young people for receiving their First Holy Communion on Easter Day. It is so important that we pray for Harry and Deborah as they continue on their Christian journeys.

Our services during Holy Week included a Taizé Service with prayers for healing on the Tuesday, a Holy Communion service with foot washing around the altar at Horndon on the Thursday, and Stations of the Cross and a Walk of Witness at Bulphan on Good Friday. The Walk of Witness culminated in the sharing of food in the Parish Room. I wonder if you can identify the mystery person in the photo sweeping up at the end!!

At this time of increased fuel costs, the foodbank is facing increased demand, but donations across the Parish have reduced. If you are able to assist, we have collection points for food in Horndon, Orsett and Bulphan. Details can be found on page two of the notices, and also on our Facebook page. In addition, it is possible to download an app onto your phone, called 'bank the food,' from wherever you usually download your apps. 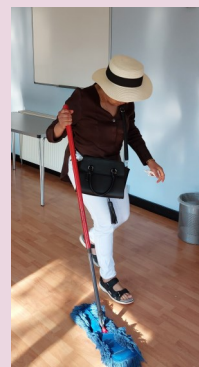

Bread has symbolic meaning. Jesus blessed and broke bread and gave it to his disciples saying 'Do this in remembrance of me'.

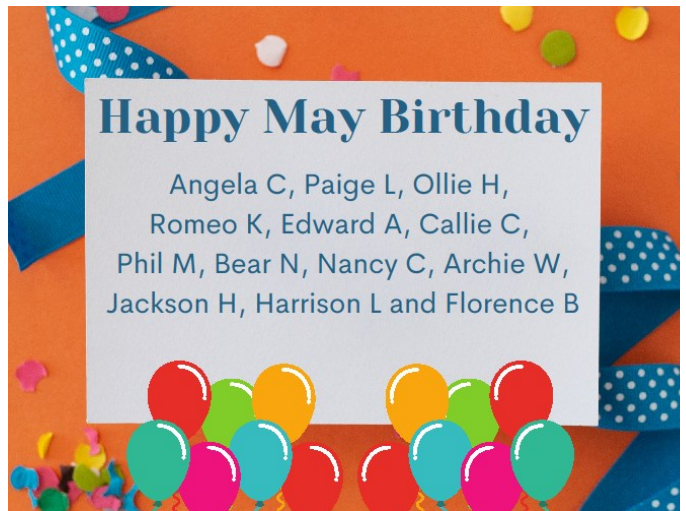
