Dear Everyone,

You may be pleased to know that, after discussion at our recent meeting, the PCC voted in favour of us beginning to receive communion in two kinds again.

We recognise that not everyone may yet feel comfortable in sharing the wine from the same cup so this will, of course, be optional. We do ask, however, for reasons of hygiene, that people do not instinct, (dip) their wafer in the wine.

With regard to setting up communion for the early communion services at Orsett and Bulphan, if anyone who regularly attends this service would be willing to take this role on, please do let me know and I can ensure that you are shown exactly what to do.

Don't forget that there is a cream tea at Orsett Churches Centre this Saturday and also Forest Church will be taking place at Bulphan. More details can be found further on in the notice sheet.
