What a celebration we had last weekend, with both the Queen's Jubilee and Pentecost. Thank you to everyone who worked so hard to make it a special and memorable time. During those four days we saw images of flames both within our Pentecost Celebrations and at the Party at the Palace as well as at the top the wonderful beacons which were lit. Just as that spirit of joy and celebration spread around the Country and the Commonwealth, so God's Holy Spirit spreads around the world and is available for each one of us in whatever situation we find ourselves.

For me, the words that have stuck with me the most from last weekend are those which we were reminded were said by the Queen said at her Coronation:, 'I declare before you all that my whole life, whether long or short, shall be devoted to your service.' And, of course, the Queen has remained true to her word. She has served the people and God faithfully. And I think these words hold a particular poignancy because they are the challenge for each of us in our Christian Faith. We are called to serve Christ, in whatever way God chooses to use us and to do so with commitment, for the long haul.
