Dear Everyone,

This Sunday is Sea Sunday when we remember the work of the Mission to Seafarers. The Mission to Seafarers say:

'We might not realise it but we all depend on seafarers. 90% of everything we use, from food and medication to cars and household furnishings, reaches us via the sea. ... being a seafarer is tough. Crews can spend months away working long hours with little respite or contact with home.

On top of the daily pressures, the threat of piracy, shipwreck and abandonment are ever present for the men and women that serve us at sea. In recent years, this challenging job has become even harder. Increased restrictions and lockdowns saw many seafarers working beyond their contract end, facing months of uncertainty and further separation from loved ones.'

Should you wish to donate towards the work of the Mission to Seafarers, who do great work, there will be an opportunity to do so this Sunday.

Thank you very much to those who contributed to the work of the MND Association last Sunday. We collected almost  $\pm 200$  .

Finally, thank you to Alastair for organising 'Count for Nature' at Orsett Church last weekend and please enjoy the photos of our participants.
