

The deal will be available throughout November and December in any of the supermarket chain's 205 cafes.

The supermarket announced the move after its latest Income Trackers showed that those aged 65 to 74 experienced a £163 drop in disposable income in August, compared to last year.

The supermarket is also running a 'Community Cuppa' campaign in its cafes by creating space for community groups, who may otherwise struggle to meet due to rising energy costs. Spaces will be available on weekdays in November and December from 2pm to 6pm and all community group members who visit will receive unlimited free tea or coffee. 
#### **Thurrock Foodbank**

One important thing that the charity asks that we use regular size shoeboxes to make packing in their lorries easier.
