If you attend a service because you wish to apply for a place for your child at a church school which requires a letter or Supplementary Information Form, please make sure, each time you attend, you sign the red attendance book which is available at the back of church.

If you attend a service to gain a Qualifying Connection in order to be married at any of the three churches, please make sure, each time you attend, you sign the <u>purple attendance book</u> which will be available at the back of church.

It is that time of year when people are thinking about school forms.

If you are hoping to send your child to Orsett C of E Primary School please make sure that when you attend a service at any of our Churches that you record this in the 'Red Book' which is available at the end of a service and please speak to one of the Churchwardens if you cannot find the book. All services are included such as Forest Church or Messy Church. If you attend church here for at least 8 times in the 12 months before submitting your application, I will then be able to complete part 2 of Orsett School's Admission Supplementary Information Form (SIF). Please remember that church attendance at Horndon, Orsett or Bulphan counts as we are one parish.

Thanks for those who have brought shoeboxes for Link to Hope. We will be able to give you the total number of boxes when we have collected the boxes from the schools. Last year we collected 75 boxes so let's hope we have equalled that this year.




