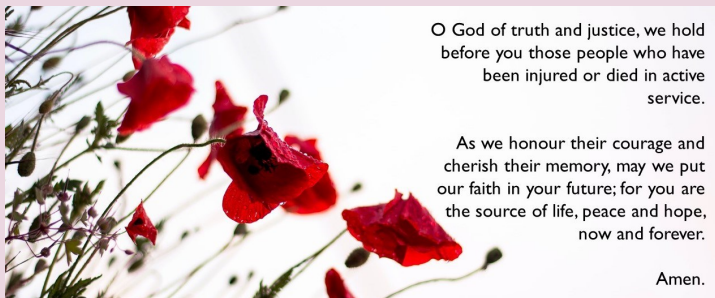

New Parish Share Scheme for 2023

In August, the new Chelmsford Diocese Parish Share Scheme was rolled out following an extensive consultation that started in Autumn last year and involved more than 500 people across the Diocese.

Each year, each parish is asked to make a parish share contribution. That contribution helps fund the training, housing and stipends of our ministers and the services that support them and their local parishes.

The Diocesan Parish Share Consultation provided a clear sense of direction for the new scheme which has a number of key features:

- **Mutual Support** – the consultation was clear that our parish share scheme should encourage mutual support between parishes in our diocese so that those who are better able to contribute, can support those in need.
- **A focus on resourcing and supporting local parish ministry.** Our new parish share scheme reaffirms our commitment to relentlessly supporting local parish ministry.
- **Journeying well together** – the new scheme has a particular focus on our relationships with each other. In particular, the scheme enables parishes to support each other and share resources across boundaries within their deaneries.
