The 10am service may be recorded for our website. If you do not wish to be recorded please speak to a churchwarden.

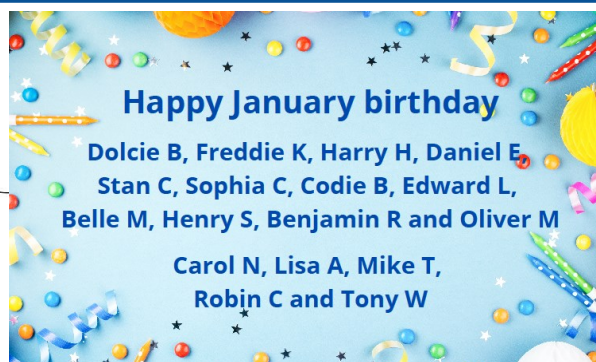
