If you attend a service to gain a Qualifying Connection in order to be married at any of the three churches, please make sure, each time you attend, you sign the purple attendance book which will be available at the back of church.

Today's Collect - Almighty and ever-living God, clothed in majesty, whose beloved Son was this day presented in the Temple, in substance of our flesh: grant that we may be presented to you with pure and clean hearts, by your Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Post Communion - Lord, you fulfilled the hope of Simeon and Anna, who lived to welcome the Messiah: may we, who have received these gifts beyond words, prepare to meet Christ Jesus when he comes to bring us to eternal life; for he is alive and reigns, now and for ever.

Dear Everyone,

We are at the end of Epiphany now and on Sunday we will be celebrating Candlemas, when we remember both the ritual purification of Mary, 40 days after the birth of her son, Jesus, and the ritual presentation of Jesus to God in the temple, where he was met by Simeon and Anna. Simeon held Jesus and called him 'a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to the people Israel.' Luke 2: 32.

There will be two services on Sunday: a 10am All Together Holy Communion Service at Orsett and a 4pm Café Church Service also at Orsett where we will be enjoying cake and doing activities based around Candlemas.

On a more solemn note, you will be aware that there have been several bereavements in the Parish in recent weeks. Please do keep the families who have lost loved ones in your prayers and please keep an eye on the Diary Dates; Advance Notices section of the weekly sheet, for details of funerals.
