

Bishop Guli's Lenten Walking Pilgrimage

Bishop Guli is undertaking a walking pilgrimage across the Diocese during Lent. During the pilgrimage, she will spend time walking with people from more thanforty churches and worshipping communities and will also be visiting schools, colleges and the Diocesan House of Retreat at Pleshey.



Bishop Guli was commissioned after the Ash Wednesday Eucharist at Chelmsford Cathedral on 22 February and began her pilgrimage the following day walking from the Cathedral to Roxwell Church of England Primary School.

Bishop Guli will be walking in all three of our Episcopal Areas. The remaining dates of her pilgrimage are as follows:

- Bradwell 3 March, accompanied by Archdeacon Mike
- Colchester 6 March, 8 March, 13 March, accompanied by Bishop Roger
- Barking 15 March, 20 March, 22 March, 28 March, accompanied by Bishop Lynne

The pilgrimage will finish at the Maundy Thursday Eucharist at Chelmsford Cathedral on Thursday 6 April. We'll be sharing pictures and stories from the Pilgrimage on our social media channels throughout Lent.
