

Deanery Synod Reps are elected for a period of 3 years and this year is the year for renewal or election. If you would like to be re-elected or elected to the Deanery Synod for the first time, please ensure that a nomination form is completed. These are available at the back of all three churches. If you would like any more information about what this role entails, please let me know.

On page three of the these notices there are the details of meetings regarding Thurrock's Local Plan. We have been asked by Chelmsford Diocese to pass this information on as it is very important that local people respond to the Council about the strategic plan for the next 15 – 20 years.
