Dear Everyone,

I hope you had an enjoyable Easter Day. We had a lovely service at Bulphan Church on Sunday after journeying through Holy Week. Thank you to everyone who worked hard to make the service special and the church look lovely.

Next week, after our 10am service at Horndon Church, we have our Annual Parochial Church Meeting, (APCM) to which everyone on the Church Electoral Roll is invited. I do encourage you to attend if you are able.

The following week, after the morning service, on Sunday 23rd April, I will be taking 6 weeks of study leave. After 10 years of ordained ministry priests are encouraged to take 3 months of study leave. My 10 years were up at the end of Covid, so I postponed my study leave until now, and will be taking it in two six week blocks; one this year and, hopefully, one next year. The purpose of study leave is two-fold. It is both for a period of spiritual refreshment and, also, to spend some time in theological reflection.

During this first part of my study leave I am planning to walk the Camino Frances from St Jean Pied de Port in France to Santiago de Compostela in Spain, following the way of St James the Apostle. As I walk, I hope to deepen my understanding of the spirituality of walking, through the lenses of moving, thinking, seeing, remembering, treading, accompanying and praying. Whilst I am doing this, I will be praying for you all and I am also hoping to raise money for Parkinsons UK and the MND Society as my husband and I each have a family member suffering from one of these conditions. Should you wish to sponsor me, I have set up a Just Giving Page and I will ask Lynda and my husband Phil to make sure that details of this are available.

Whilst I am away, my husband, Phil, will be at home for most of the time, and I am very grateful that the wardens, Revd Max, Revd Moji and Lynda Robertson will be available to help with any queries. Any prayer requests for the notices should be sent to Lynda. Please note that Moji works at a school on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays so won't be available for ministry on these days.

Thank you for allowing me the time to undertake this pilgrimage and please do pray for me as I walk.

I will be writing one more piece for next week's notices before I go and will be available to answer any queries until the morning of Sunday 23rd April.
