Dear Everyone,

Thank you very much to everyone who helped to make the Deanery Tent at the Orsett Show a great success last week. The sun shone and the day went well with lots of visitors to the tent.

I thought you might like to know that here have been some new appointments in the Diocese. Following the news that the Venerable Adam Atkinson, will begin serving as the Bishop of Bradwell later in the year, we have just heard that two new archdeacons have been appointed, to begin serving in November.

The Revd Kate Peacock, who currently serves as Deputy Director of Mission and Ministry for the Diocese of St Albans will become the new Archdeacon of Stansted. Kate will succeed the Venerable Robin King who is retiring at the end of September.

The Revd Jonathan Croucher will become the new Archdeacon of Chelmsford, succeeding the Venerable Elizabeth Snowden who retired in October last year. Jonathan currently serves in the Diocese of Southwark where he is Vicar of Christ Church Gipsy Hill, Priest in Charge of Emmanuel West Dulwich and Area Dean of Lambeth South.

Please do pray for Adam, Kate and Jonathan as they prepare to move. Please also pray for our own Archdeacon, Mike who, in the meantime, continues to cover all these roles.

More locally, this is to let you know that I am proposing to make Forest Church on 7th October a camping out Forest Church and then all coming together in worship at the Family Service in Orsett Church on the Sunday morning. Food will be provided but you will need to bring your own tent and all children or adults with additional needs

will need to be accompanied by an adult who will take full responsibility for them, including health and dietary needs. If you would like to be part of this camp out Forest Church, please let me know and I will give you further details. I hope that we will be able to accommodate everyone who wishes to come but if there are more people than space available, places will be given on a first come first served basis.
