


## Welcome to the Parish of Horndon, Orsett and Bulphan

**Today's Collect** - Almighty and ever-living God, clothed in majesty, whose beloved Son was this day presented in the Temple, in substance of our flesh: grant that we may be presented to you with pure and clean hearts, by your Son Jesus Christ our ord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Dear Everyone,

This Sunday, the season of Epiphany draws to a close as we celebrate Candlemas. Candlemas is when we remember both the ritual purification of Mary, 40 days after the birth of her son, Jesus, and the ritual presentation of Jesus to God in the Temple, at Jerusalem, where he was met by Anna and Simeon.

Simeon held Jesus and called him 'a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to [the] people Israel.' Luke 2:32. Do come along to one of our services, both of which are at Bulphan Church and details of which are above.

Don't forget, also, the Alpha Course begins this Sunday at 4pm at Orsett Churches Centre. It's not too late to sign up. All are welcome. If you haven't signed up but would like to come along, please just turn up.

### Eco Pause for Thought - LUNCH PACKAGING

If you're getting lunch while you're out, consider options to cut down on disposable packaging. For example, could you eat-in at a coffee shop rather than getting things to-go? This allows reusable crockery to be used, r emoves packaging for lunch options, and reduces waste as reusables will be washed afterwards. Alternatively, if you do need to get food to-go, could you bring your own container to a local café, sandwich shop, or food stall? By asking businesses to refill your container, you save them money and save the planet from disposable plastic! Some businesses will reward customers with a discount for bringing their own reusable lunch container, so always check with the owner.
