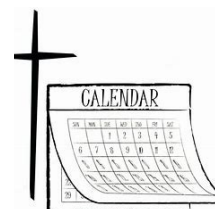

Harvest Festival

As you can appreciate this year we will not be able to hold our normal Harvest Festival Services at each church however there will be a Benefice Harvest Service at Orsett Church Sunday 27th September at 10am. During the Covid crisis, as a Benefice, we have donated a total of 1,477kg (almost 1.5 tonnes!) of goods to the Thurrock Foodbank. How wonderful it would be if we could all make an extra effort during the Harvest month of September. In addition to the five collection boxes listed below there will also be a box at the Service on 27th September.

This week they are short of - jam, cooking sauces such as curry, chicken tikka, honey and mustard etc (but no pasta sauces please as we have loads of those), sponge puddings, whole milk (no other sorts of milk please), snacks, tinned fruit (not peaches please), mashed potato. They are also very low on toiletries especially shampoo. As children are back at school COVID guidelines mean parents have to wash uniforms more so there is a need for washing powder and detergents.
