Dear All,

Now we are into the second lockdown, my thoughts are with you all as we all wait, hopeful that the vaccines which the Government has ordered will be successful.

It was so good that we were able to hold our Remembrance Services at all three village war memorials and thank you to all those of you who helped to make these events happen. This year there were many anniversaries to remember: VE 75, VJ 75, Battle of Britain 80, 100 years since the burial of the unknown warrior and, on 15th September, the unveiling of the plaque at Bulphan, to mark the spot where, in 1940, Spitfire Pilot Officer, Gerald Archibald Langley RAFVR ("Gerry") of 41 Squadron, was killed in action, aged only 24 years old. It was moving to see community members gather to mark Remembrance Sunday, with representatives from the various uniformed organisations in all three villages, there are some photographs on page two. We appreciated the sound of the beautiful lament played at Bulphan by their very own piper Jo and, thanks to Anton, Mike and Ron, Bulphan's Tommy was ready for the occasion.

Whilst Forest Church won't be able to go ahead in person, I am planning on holding an online Forest Church at 4pm on Saturday 14th November. This will be livestreamed on our Facebook page: @HOBNOBChurches. For this, you will need a candle in a jam jar, a large piece of paper, some leaves and natural objects and some glue. I will be lighting a fire outdoors in our firepit and, if you are able and want to do the same in your garden, then please do that! But don't worry if you can't, a candle in a jam jar will be fine!


